



Blackburn Cathedral, in partnership with Churches Together in Lancashire, is hosting a three-day ecumenical conference to celebrate the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea, exploring how the Church can address division through dialogue, compassion and shared faith.

Bringing together theologians, ecumenical leaders and local participants to engage in meaningful conversations about unity, respectful disagreement and how faith communities can respond to conflict in today's world.

The conference opens with an in-depth exploration of the Nicene Creed, featuring responses from leading theologians and ecumenists. Participants can then take part in seminars, workshops and enjoy opportunities for open dialogue and networking, concluding with an ecumenical service in the Cathedral. On Sunday morning, Canon Dr Jeremy Morris, National Adviser for Ecumenical Relations for the Church of England, will preach at the Cathedral Eucharist.



The British Textile Biennial (BTB) commissions and presents work inspired by the context and legacy of the textile industry in East Lancashire and its global impact.

 $This Autumn, BTB25 explores invention and innovation in textile production; through indigenous knowledge to space-age technology. Blackburn Cathedral is delighted to be hosting: {\bf Lucy \& Jorge Orta-Homo Mondialis}.$

 $This survey \ exhibition \ of the work \ of Lucy \ and Jorge \ Orta, across \ continents \ over thirty \ years \ from \ the \ Antarctic \ to \ the \ Amazon, reflects \ on \ humanity's \ impact \ and \ relationship \ with \ the \ planet.$

This striking installation will occupy the Crypt, inviting us to travel from the South Pole through jungles, deserts and forests to reflect with them. At its centre, is a major new commission, House of Hair, which reimagines and reconstructs the traditional Bedouin tent as a speculative response to nomadic living in the extreme scenario of mass desertification.



The Complete Organ Works - which last around 80 minutes - will be performed by Blackburn Cathedral Director of Music, John Robinson.


